

# **AGENCY FOR ASSISTANCE & DEVELOPMENT OF AFGHANISTAN FACT SHEET**

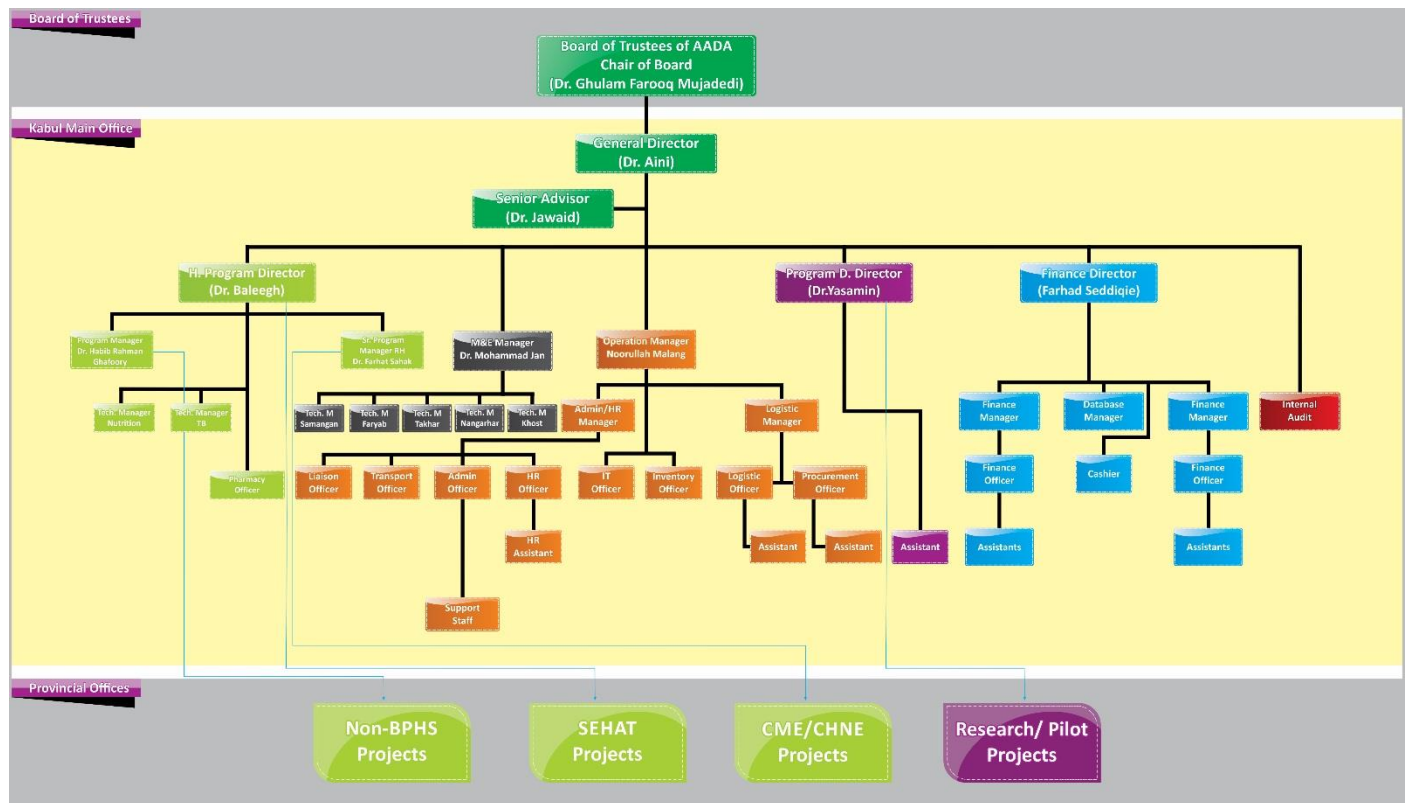
Agency for Assistance and Development of Afghanistan (AADA) is a non-political, non-profit, and independent Afghan organization founded in 2005. It was established with the main and foremost aim of provision of quality health and social services, profession capacity building, and promotion of equal access of communities to developmental and humanitarian services.

Since its inception, AADA has been implementing program and projects in various areas such as Basic Package of Health Services (BPHS) that is based on Primary Health Care programs. AADA has also been extensively involved in implementing projects aimed at community development, and capacity building of both health workers and community levels. AADA has also successfully conducted researches and consultancies in public health and other development areas.

Through the direction and guidance from AADA's Board of Trustees, we are in the process of development of consultation and collaboration with international institution to keep AADA's health, education and service delivery to international standards. Beyond that, AADA is committed to substantially involving communities in assessment of needs, choice of target, and development/evaluation of programs.

The strategic direction of the organization is formulated and monitored by the Board of Trustees. The first strategic plan of the organization was formulated for 5 years through which most focus was given to institutional development and expansion of the entity throughout Afghanistan. The strategic plan for year 2011-2015 pursues the ambitions of organization making it a global development partner through exchange of experiences, fundraising, and establishing connections with international entities.

AADA is governed by the "Board of Trustees" that was come into existence from establishment of the organization; it governs the organization and provides overall policy direction to achieve its aims in the most efficient and effective manner, consistent with the organization's values and approaches, and in line with the Afghan government constitutions. Supervised by Board of Trustees, the management team of AADA Main Office is responsible for overall management of all AADA projects throughout the country. The management team is consisting of General Director, Program Advisor, Program Director, Program Development Director, Finance Director , Head M&E and Operation Manager.



## AADA at a Glance

Since its establishment, AADA has a proven record of successful implementation of training, and community development projects in several provinces of Afghanistan, reaching more than 2.5 million populations in the country. So far, AADA has been executing training and service delivery projects in more than 20 provinces of Afghanistan, which include: Kabul, Ghazni, Wardak, Logar, Khost, Paktya, Paktika, Urozgan, Herat, Kandahar, Kunduz, Jawzjan, Faryab, Balkh, Daikundi, Bamyán, Parwan, Panjsher, Kapisa, Samangan, Takhar and Nangarhar provinces. AADA's projects have been financially and technically supported by a diverse set of donors that includes: Government of Afghanistan, WHO, USAID/IRD/ARD, World Bank, UNDP, UNFPA, UNICEF, MSH, Global Fund, BMZ/THE JOHANNITER, OCHA and WFP.

AADA has always adopted peculiar approach in project design and implementation. Capacity building, promoting coordination, assuring quality and client satisfaction and securing sustainability have remained the core working principles of AADA in executing projects.
